



## **WESTERHAM BREWERY VISITOR GUIDELINES**

**Westerham Brewery takes all necessary measures to ensure the safety of visitors and the quality of the beers we provide to our customers.**

We welcome visitors to our brewery. However, to prevent any risk of food contamination, it is important that our visitors follow certain guidelines as detailed below.

- Visitors should be clean and neat and behave in a hygienic manner at all times. You must follow any guidelines or requests made by staff while on the premises.
- If you are spending time in our production area please be aware it is a working brewery and care should be taken when moving around.
- Please observe the hand washing posters in hand washing areas.
- Smoking is not permitted on the premises.
- Please contact us in advance of your visit if you suffer from any infectious illness or have done so within the last 14 days. This includes gastroenteritis, diarrhoea, vomiting or similar illness among close contacts.
- You should inform brewery staff of any incident that may occur while you are in the brewery that may put food safety at risk. (please be aware we have a very strict no nut and no sesame policy within the brewery).
